Events: Number of players accepted for main rounds:
MS - 64, WS - 64, MD - 32, WD - 32, XD – 48

It is required that every event in a particular Junior Circuit tournament has at least 8 competitors (i.e. actual competitors, not merely entries). If the required number of competitors is not met, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

Entries: Entries shall be made in order of strength in each event and have to be received by the organizer no later than 21st October 2011. The Member Association that enters a player into a Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player. For all the players withdrawing in the meantime the Organizers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member Association. All the entries must be confirmed by the National Associations. No late entries will be accepted.

Withdrawals: After entering a player(s) in the tournament it is the Member Nation's responsibility to secure visas for their players – if this is needed. Make sure that visa applications are made early enough. Any withdrawals must be announced in writing and accompanied by a medical certificate or other appropriate documentation.

Conditions: The tournament will be played on elimination system. The tournament will be run strictly in accordance with the Competition Regulations of the BWF and the Badminton Europe Junior Circuit 2011/2012 Regulations. Advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF's Regulations 19.-23. According to Slovak laws Drug Testing may be carried out on a random basis at any time. Insurance have to be arranged by participants.

Visa: All participants, who need a visa, should request for invitational letter from organizer in time.

Attention:
